The **Borderline** exhibition **"Artsong"** opens at the **Forest to Furniture Gallery** on **Sunday June 3** - to coincide with the Wintersong Carnival in Tenterfield (June 18 – 26).

The opening will be a "Brunch" with Amanda from the Coach House Café at Lyra doing the catering. Entry to the event will be by donation (for Borderline) and patrons will pay for food and drink. So please keep the morning of June 3 free and invite all your friends.

We would like as many works as possible so please participate. There will be an entry fee of \$5 per work. Works can be left at Forest to Furniture (or at my place at 5 Jubilee Street). For people from the Stanthorpe area, works can be left with Linda Clutterbuck at her workplace at Chandler Macleod. Please ensure works have protective wrapping.

There is no theme for this show, though this could change in future years, when the lead-in time will be greater. And while new works would be great, any past works that have not been shown in Tenterfield would be acceptable.

Borderline has agreed to have a float in the Wintersong Street Parade on Saturday June 23. Chris Hangan is letting us paint her old campervan, and perhaps we will tow a trailer with an artist at an easel painting a picture. Any ideas (and volunteers) would be appreciated. Perhaps people, including children, in paint spattered clothing (face painting) could walk along side carrying examples of our work etc.

A recent van painting day was washed out, so another effort will be organized. Maybe during our exhibition, or perhaps at the opening.

Also, we would like to invite visitors to the exhibition to help create one (or more) largish abstracts by cutting and pasting colourful shapes onto a board. To do this we need members to provide sheets of coloured paper eg cartridge painted with single colours.

More details, entry forms, invitations will be forthcoming.

The **Tom Spence Project** is moving slowly towards a painting start. Paint and brushes have been bought and some frames have been stretched. Rather than having a general roster, we have decided to plan the roster around each work. So it will be a matter of deciding which work to do and then looking for people to help.
