Christine (arts educator, watercolourist/ print maker, and business mentor) will be stationed at the Tenterfield Rail Museum and Forest to Furniture Gallery for a week long Winter Residency.

From **June 15 to 22**, artists (in any medium) will be encouraged to experiment with new techniques, to increase skills, and create a body of work for exhibition.

Professional development is a key aspect of the program, including copyright, marketing and sales integrity.

The program starts with 2 workshops
One day of watercolour (Saturday June 15)
One day of dry point printmaking (Sunday

June 16).

This will be followed by 4 days of creative challenge - with classes in drawing, field sketching, life drawing, portraits, excursions and more.
